

BYLAW NO. 4 - 2016

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE MOUNTAIN NO. 63
RESPECTING ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE**

Pursuant to *The Stray Animals Act*, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Expressions used in this bylaw have the same meaning and interpretations given to them by section 2 of *The Stray Animals Act*.
2. The following animals are permitted to run at large in the following areas within the Municipality within the following times:
 - (a) AREA:
 - All those portions of the original road allowance and lands taken for roadway lying South of the Northerly boundary of the West South West Quarter of Section 15, Township 09, Range 03, West of the 2nd Meridian and North of the Southerly boundary of the West North West Quarter Section of 03, Township 09, Range 03, West of the 2nd Meridian.
 - (b) ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE:
 - Cattle
 - (c) PERIOD
 - January 1st to December 31st of each year.
3. Bylaw No. 7-1977 is hereby repealed.
