

**BYLAW NO. 7-2017**

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE MOUNTAIN NO. 63,  
TO PROVIDE FOR A BASE TAX**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63,  
in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax Bylaw".
2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property included in the table below:

| ty                      | Type of Property |              |
|-------------------------|------------------|--------------|
|                         | Land             | Improvements |
| Agriculture             | nil              | nil          |
| Residential             | nil              | nil          |
| Commercial & Industrial | nil              | \$550.00     |

3. Notwithstanding section 2 of this bylaw, a base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property situated within the **Organized Hamlet of Cannington Lake Resort**, included in the table below.

| Property Class          | Type of Property |              |
|-------------------------|------------------|--------------|
|                         | Land             | Improvements |
| Agriculture             | nil              | nil          |
| Residential             | \$100.00         | \$100.00     |
| Commercial & Industrial | nil              | nil          |

4. Where a property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the base tax calculation shall be considered independently and applied to each classification.
5. Bylaw No. 5-2014 is hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into effect on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.
