BYLAW NO. 2-2002

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

	In this bylaw the expression:
	(a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act:
	(b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
2.	No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than fifty (50) kilometres per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows:
	(a) between Sections ENE 22 and WNW 23, Township 09, Range 01, West of 2nd.
3.	Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4.	Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
5.	This bylaw comes into effect upon approval of the Highway Traffic Board.
