

## BYLAW NO. 2 -2024

### A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE MOUNTAIN NO. 63 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING FIRE FIGHTING RATES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63,  
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Fire Rates Bylaw.
2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the following rates:
  - ⇒ costs to be charged for the cost of fire prevention and suppression,
  - ⇒ other rates for firefighters meetings, practices, honorarium and administration.
3. That the rates charged be as follows:
