

BYLAW 1-2019

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE MOUNTAIN NO. 63 TO AMEND BYLAW 2-2006,
KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63

In the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. To amend Bylaw No. 2-2006 as follows:

A. Section 5:A – Agricultural District, Subsection 5.3 District Regulations, Subsection (2), is amended by removing:

- A quarter section, which is located within this district, may be allowed under Section 5.3.2 (b) i) of the BPS to have a maximum of 3 sites subdivided from it(4 separate titles per quarter section in total) for a principal use allowed in this District.

And replaced with:

- A quarter section, which is located within this district, may be allowed under Section 5.3.2 (b) i) of the BPS to have a maximum of 4 site subdivided form it(5 separate titles per quarter section in total) for a principal use allowed in this District.

2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.
