### **APPROACH / CULVERT INSTALLATION – (Including Residential)**

All individuals and/or companies wishing to construct an approach on a municipal road allowance shall adhere to the following:

1. Every application for a road approach shall first be approved by Council before it may be installed.
2. The cost of constructing the approach and supplying the culvert shall be the responsibility of the land owner/applicant.
3. Company officials must meet or contact the landowner and our Councillor prior to construction. At this time, any concerns associated with the construction of the approach may be discussed.
4. When a new subdivision is requested, the applicant shall be responsible for providing access to the new subdivision as well as ensuring access is available to the remainder of the land not subdivided but owned by the applicant. Access shall include an approach and culvert at the expense of the applicant. *(Res.#151/14)*
5. For safety and to facilitate our road side mowing maintenance program, the approach shall be constructed with a 5:1 slope.
6. Upon completion of constructing the approach, the approach must be gravelled with 7/8" road gravel.
7. Should the approach not meet these standards, the Municipality will order the landowner to have the approach reconstructed.
8. Any approach improvements or alterations must first meet with Council approval.
9. A minimum diameter culvert of 450mm, larger if necessary, shall be installed at the time of the initial construction of the approach.
10. All temporary approaches must meet the conditions as stipulated by the Councillor and or Council before construction approval is issued.
11. No person shall plough (snow or trees) on roads or portions thereof in the Municipality except by written authority of the Municipal Council,
12. Approval's provided by the R.M. shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance.
