## **BYLAW NO. 1-2015**

## A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE MOUNTAIN NO. 63 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING FIRE FIGHTING RATES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Mountain No. 63, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Fire Rates Bylaw.
